The FF72 is a firefighter scooper aircraft derived from the ATR 72, designed and manufactured in France, capable of meeting the need to replace the Canadair fleet from 2028 with a modern aircraft and improved performance.

The FF72-X1 project aims at developing the know-how and skills of a seaplane design office in France, through the manufacturing and flight testing of an ATR 72 demonstrator on floats.

The intern will participate in establishing the Safety Management System (SMS) of Positive Aviation design through:

- supporting the launch of FF72-X1 demonstrator flight test phase; the process will need to address the development, maintenance and operations of the demonstrator aircraft
- preparing the overall SMS that will be set for Positive Aviation as a Design Organisation Approval Holder
